The last half of the Sike Lane footpath is difficult to walk and so it was agreed to ask our contractor to cut it.

19/06 PLANNING

Application: planning enforcement at Crab Manor/Asenby Lodge.

Harrogate Council has informed us of a possible breach of planning control at the above location; it would appear that 7 structures have been erected without listed building consent or planning approval. Also Harrogate Council have noted the issue of the rear access and the impact on the footpath and the highway and asked the hotel how they will rectify this.
